 sbs steering I & E at 4 PM board
 for Black fish and gut one Middle
 part light air Latter part fine breeze
 from K & E sbs by the wind heading
 I & W sciences Lat 10° 40' N
 Long 20° 33' W

Remarks on board Sunday 12th
 First part fine breeze from I
 sbs heading I & W Middle part and
 Latter part light air from I sbs
 heading to the W & W sciences
 Lat 10° 08' N
 Long 21° 52' W
