

Remarks on Board Bark Louise

For these 24 hours a fine breeze from the East steering W by W under all sail employed in Ship's duty

Sunday 14th
For these 24 hours the same a fine breeze steering W by W under all sail

Sunday 15th
Commenced with a fine breeze steering W by W under all sail Middle part the same Later part at daylight took in the Star Boat to repair at 9 AM raised a school of large sperm whales on the Star Bow took in studding sails and luffed to the wind lowered the boats Mr Clifford went on and struck Waist & Bow Boats struck the same whale turned him up and took him along side so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday 16th
Commenced with fine weather cutting in at 5 PM set the studding sails and kept her off steering W by N Middle part employed in cutting up junk later part boiling & repairing boat

Wednesday 17th
For these 24 hours employed in boiling & painting boat

Thursday 18th
For the first part of these 24 hours boiling at sunset cooled down took in the Bow Boat and put the Star Boat on the cranes Middle part fine Later part the same employed in painting Star Boat and repairing Bow Boat

Friday 19th
For these 24 hours employed in coopers oil putting out Bow Boat and pumping salt water in after hold

Saturday 20th
For these 24 hours employed in stowing down oil sucking out Bread &c &c

Bound to the Okhotsk Sea 1858

Sunday March 21st
For the first part of these 24 hours employed in washing ship Middle part fine Later part the same steering W under all sail nothing in sight

Monday 22nd
Commenced with a fine breeze steering W under all sail Middle part the same Later part a fine breeze employed in painting Waist & Bow Boats

Tuesday 23rd
For these 24 hours Employed in small jobs steering W by N nothing in sight

Wednesday 24th
For these 24 hours the same employed in the rigging & painting W & Bow Boats

Thursday 25th
For these 24 hours a fine breeze steering W by N under all sail turned up the Waist & Bow Boats, getting eating gies &c

Friday 26th
Commenced with a fine breeze steering W by N under all sail Middle part the same Later part the same employed in the rigging

Saturday 27th
Commenced with a fine breeze steering W by N under all sail Middle part the same attended with squalls of rain. Later part the same rainy took in the light studding sails

Sunday 28th
Commenced with squally rainy weather employed in ship's duty Middle part fair weather Later part the same raised a school of sperm whales 2 points off the Star Bow lowered the boats for them Star Boat struck & drew Star Boat struck killed whale Bow Boat struck killed whale & took them along side at sunset shortened sail & went to supper
