Okhotsk Sea



Saturday
15th
May

About the Okhotsk Sea 1858
Commences with a fine breeze from the SE steering NW by W trying to get in the sea & sail in sight Middle part a light breeze at 10 o'clock passed through the straits a sail in the passage Latter part a fine breeze from the NE steering NW 3 sail in sight

Sunday
16th

Commences with a fine light breeze steering NW under all sail 3 sail in sight Middle part a fine breeze Latter part the same breeze Ship Barnstable of New Bedford 30 months out 1750 lbs Capt. Pease of Ship Oregon on board with a boats crew he lost his ship 11th in the fog & ends these 24 hours

Monday
17th

Commences with thick fog the Barnstable on the weather quarter Middle part calm Latter part the same part a new boat on the cranes and put the old boat for the S B Boat put up davits and put her on the cranes Barnstable on the Larb quarter & ends these 24 hours

Tuesday
18th

Commences with a light breeze sent down m top gall sail & Foresail topmast-ludding sail boom & rigging on bent studding sails & sent up the old m top gallant & Foresail Middle part calm Latter part the same broke out Tow lines & runn two shots & ends these 24 hours

Wednesday
19th

For these 24 hours a light breeze with fog steering NW by W
