

Remarks on Board Whale
Friday August 13th Commences with light winds from the N.E. and foggy employed Boiling Boats off in pursuit of whales " " Middle & Latter parts Foggy employed in boiling

Saturday August 14th For these 24 hours a light breeze attended with fog finished Boiling Boats off after whales.

Sunday 15th For these 24 hours light winds from the N.E. Boats off lay alive with whales but none for the Louisa to day several whales struck by different ships Boats &c

Monday 16th Light winds a number of small whales about the bay Boats all off trying to get a crack at one no wind no wind

Tuesday 17th Commences with a light breeze and clear weather Bow Boat struck turned whale up and took him along side and finished cutting at 4 PM Middle part Fine Latter part the same thick fog Boats of chasing employed in repairing Laboard Boat &c

Wednesday August 18th Commences with a fine light breeze from the E. and clear weather Boats off Middle part same with thunder and lightning Latter part thick foggy weather employed Boiling Boats off

Thursday August 19th For these 24 hours boiling stowing down 50 ships in sight so boiling Wind from the N.E. plenty of whales

Bark Louisa about 11th Bay 89.558

Friday August 20th Commences with fresh breezes from the N.E. and rainy finished Boiling and stowing down Middle & Latter parts a fine breeze from the N.E. Boats all down on board employed in scraping bone

Saturday 21st Commences with fresh breezes and fair weather got under weigh and stood over to north shore

Sunday 22nd Commences with light breezes at 2 PM came to an anchor near the North shore in 12 fathoms water saw several whales fast at night Middle part fine " " Latter part a strong breeze Boats lowered at 3 AM headed in shore whales numerous Waist Boat struck turned him up and all the Boats commenced towing in company with Bark Fanny's Boats

Monday 23rd Commences with strong breezes from the N.E. hove up anchor and took Waist Boats whale along side at 2 PM let go anchor again and commenced cutting in at 5 PM finished cutting at 6 PM got under weigh again blowing strong and rugged Middle & Latter parts the same ship under weigh

Tuesday 24th Commences with strong breezes and rugged at 6 PM came to anchor under the North shore in 10 fathoms water the Fanny near by " Middle & Latter parts fine employed Boiling 3 Boats looking for whales 1 Boat wooding

Wednesday 25th For these 24 hours fine employed in Boiling wooding let Bark Fanny have 4 Pipes of Bread
