

Remarks on Board Ship *Louisa* About
 Tuesday 7th September Commenced with a strong breeze at 3 PM
 got under weigh. Boats returned saw a few
 whales working out the bay. Middle & Latter
 parts fine weather employed Boiling
 boats off after whales " "

Wednesday 8th Commenced with calm weather saw a great
 many whales could not get on, no wind,
 employed Boiling. Middle part light
 winds from the S.W. Latter part at daybreak
 called all hands at 5 AM lowered the
 boats. Wait Boat went on and struck
 he turned his whale up and took him
 along side and cut him in by 10 AM
 latter part light breezes from the S.W.
 and fine finished Boiling the other
 two whales saw a great many whales

Thursday 9th Commenced with light airs and calms
 boats off chasing whales returned at night
 Middle part light winds Latter part
 fresh breezes from the S.W. and good
 weather working up the bay "

Friday 10th Commenced with fresh breezes from
 the S.W. and good weather At 2 PM
 kept off for Felixstow Harbour
 for wood & water Middle & Latter
 parts light winds from the S.W. employed
 Boiling

Saturday 11th Commenced with light breezes from
 the E and good weather came to an
 anchor at 6 PM in Felixstow Harbour
 in 9 fathoms water Middle part boiling
 Latter part employed in Boiling. Stowing
 down, wooding & watering, several ships at anchor

Sunday 12th Commenced with fresh breezes from the S.W.
 at 5 PM let go Starb Anchor to slip up from
 dragging got off a raft of water Middle part
 more moderate. A Comet in sight
 to the West " " " "

 Monday 13th September For these 24 hours fine weather
 employed in wooding Ship
 Lexington of Nantucket wooding

Tuesday 14th Commenced with fresh breezes from
 the S.W. employed wooding Sent a new
 Main Trawl & Foreail Middle part
 fine Latter part the same one boat
 brought along side some stakes cut
 for studding-sail booms Took our
 Anchor at 5 AM Sailed over to
 the North shore " "

Wednesday 15th For these 24 hours a light breeze
 from the S.W. working along the
 coast to the N.E.

Thursday 16th Commenced with fresh breezes from the
 S.W. and clear weather By the wind
 making to the N.E. The Coast distant
 4 miles Middle & Latter part
 calm saw one whale going quick
 Five ships in sight 2 boiling
 " " Lat per Obs 55.30 N, Long 13.50 E

Friday 17th For these 24 hours a light breeze
 from the E. cruising along the
 coast saw several ships but no
 whales " "

Saturday 18th For these 24 hours a strong breeze from the S.W.
 cruising along the coast to the N.E.
 Lat per Obs 55.47 N Long 13.14 E

Sunday 19th For these 24 hours running along
 the land to the N.E. Coast distant
 20 miles " " Lat 57.25 N Long 14.16 E

Monday 20th For these 24 hours this same
 Coast 5 miles distant
 Lat per Obs 58.39 N, Lon 14.25 E
