Thursday 9th December For these 24 hours light winds from the SE in company with Bark Massachusetts Capt Hathaway on board of her took on board a ship

Friday 10th Commenced with light breezes coming with Massachusetts took a small anchor from her and took it on our Larboard bow at 7 P.M. Capt came on board, Middle part fine Latter part the same

Saturday 11th For these 24 hours light breezes from the SE Bark Massachusetts on the Larboard beam " " Lat 18.21 N Long 159.48 W

Sunday 12th For the first & Middle parts a light breeze from the SE steering SE Latter part rainy nothing doing

Monday 13th For the first part of these 24 hours squally with rain wind from North steering SE Middle & Latter parts the same

Tuesday 14th For these few days back buffing winds from the Eastward and squally steering by the wind to the SE employed in painting Boats repairing Sails &c &c &c

Wednesday 15th Commenced with moderate breezes from the North and squally steering SE by E Middle & Latter parts the same " " Lat 10.59 N Long 158.18 West

Thursday 16th Commenced with strong breezes from the NNE squally course SE by E Middle & Latter parts the same

Friday 17th Commenced with strong breeze from the NNE attended with squalls of rain course SE by E Middle & Latter parts the same

Saturday 18th Lat fur Obs C. 40 N Long 158.18 W

Tuesday 19th Commenced with moderate breezes and squally steering by the wind to the SE Middle part strong wind and squally saw a ship on the Starboard beam Latter part moderate breezes from the SE Eastward and fair weather steering by the wind to the SE employed in repairing fly jib

Wednesday 20th Commenced with moderate breezes from the SE and fair weather steering by the wind to the SE Middle & Latter parts the same Lat fur Obs 4.44 N Long 155.34 W

Thursday 21st For these 24 hours fine trades from the SE and fair weather steering by the wind to the SE employed in the rigging Lat fur Obs 2.55 N Long 156.23 W

Friday 22nd For these 24 hours fine trades steering South employed in the rigging " " Lat fur Obs 4.02 N Long 157.00 W

Saturday 23rd For these 24 hours fine breeze from the Eastward and good weather steering by the wind to the SE employed in the rigging " Lat fur Obs 11.38 N Long 156.52 W

Sunday 24th For these 24 hours fine trades from E SE and good weather steering by the wind to the SE Lat fur Obs 3.28 N Long 156.22 W

Monday 25th For these 24 hours the same employed in repairing spare Boats over head & other small jobs " " Lat fur Obs 5.38 N Long 157.00 W
