Sunday 22nd May. A.D. 1859
Commenced with thick weather spoke
ship Mary Frasier & Bark Camilla
& gammed with them Ice on the Starb
Bow Middle part under short sail
Latter part the same Ship Hesperidon
of Haver off the beam " " "

" " Monday 23rd
Commenced with a light breeze from
the ESE steering NE under easy sail
Ship Hesperidon off larb quarter
Middle part a thick fog steering NE
under easy sail Latter part a thick
fog wind from the East steering West
under easy sail " " "

" " Tuesday 24th
Commenced with a thick fog under
easy sail wind East steering West passed
a ship heading to the ESE at 6 P.M.
made heavy Ice stood in hand and
then stood off Middle part a thick
fog under short sail Latter part
the same heading S.W. under all sail
" Lat 52.10 N. Long 141.59 East

" " Wednesday 25th
Commenced with a light breeze from
SE steering by the wind along the Ice
exchanged signals with a Bremen ship
Middle part a thick fog steering S.W.
under all sail at 3 A.M. came to the
Ice wore ship and hauled on the
wind heading NW by N at daylight wore
ship steering to the S.W. along the
Ice a thick fog for this last day

" " Thursday 26th
Commenced with a thick fog running along
the Ice heading S.W. Middle part a thick fog
Latter part the same a light breeze

" " Friday 27th
Commenced with a thick fog & calm
employed in suaking out Bread Trip
Middle part the same Latter part
a thick fog Ice on the Starb quarter
lowered down the Mast boat and shot
1 doz ducks for a fresh meat no prospects
of clear weather " " "

" " Saturday 28th Ice
Commenced with a light breeze from
the W steering by the wind heading
S.W. under all sail at 6 P.M. came
to the Ice tacked ship and stood
off again Middle part the same
heading to the S.W. Latter part
beating up to St. Jonas Island Ice broken
up 13 miles in sight under easy sail
working through the Ice

" " Sunday 29th
Commenced with a light breeze from
the beating through the Ice a
thick fog Middle part beating back
in a clear strip of water a thick fog
Latter part a strong breeze from
the S.W. steering by the wind to the
W by N under easy sail through fields
of Ice
" Lat 52.10 N. Long 150.00 East

" " Monday 30th
Commenced with a strong breeze from West
beating up through fields of Ice to
St. Jonas Island distance by observations
150 miles 2 sail on the Starb Bow
working up Middle part under easy sail
working through fields of heavy Ice
Latter part a thick fog beating aback
2 miles off Starb Bow in the Ice
