

" " Monday 3th
Commenced with a strong breeze from
the S^E attended with squalls of rain
but I ran in the topsails & took
in the spankers. Middle part
blowing a gale from the S^E ship
rove to under a close reefed main-
top-sail. Latter part at daylight gale
drove, made sail very rugged
finished strapping down the

" " Tuesday 8th
Commenced with a light breeze from
the W steering E by S a heavy swell from
the SE employed in small jobs " "
Middle part the same squally
later part a strong breeze from the
W steering E by S carried away main yard
sent it down & commenced getting out
a new one very rugged " "

Wednesday 9th
Commenced with a strong breeze from
the S W steering E by S under double reef
top sails employed in getting out a main
top gallant yard fitting 15 ft & 100 ft ropes
middle part the same. Latter part
the same employed in fitting M & Gallant
rigging fitting new yard. &c &c

For the 24 hours a strong breeze from the
N by steering E & E at 12 PM wind hauled
to the West strong breeze & squally, at
daylight made sail sent aloft & crossed
the top gallant yard sent the sails steering
S E by E, set the studding sails "

Friday 14th
Commenced with a strong breeze from
the S.W. steering S.E. & took in studding
-sails to main royal, employed in small
jobs. Middle part usually took in
the light sails. Latter part the
same employed in small jobs
Breaking out Bread, hauling yarn for sailthings
&c &c

" " Saturday 12th
 Commenced with a strong breeze from
 the S.W. and squally steering S.E. by E under
 prudent sail. Middle part
 the same latter part wind from
 the N.W. steering S.E. by E under full sail
 " " Lat 34.32 Long 16.56 N

For the first & middle parts of these
24 hours a fine breeze from the N.W.
steering S.E. under all sail. Latter part
wind hauled to the S.W. took in the studding
- sails & hauled on the wind, heading S.E.

" Monday 14th
Commenced with a strong breeze from N.W.
steering by the wind heading S.E. Middle part the
same latter part the same continuing on
Lat 38 1/2. Long 14 6.00 W
