employed in washing & repairing
barrels &c &c
" " " Lat per Obs 23.27 N Long 155.14 W

" " " Thursday 17th
Commenced with light breezes from the
S by E steering by the wind employed in
washing & repairing barrels &c &c
Middle part a light
breeze latter part took the S by E
trades went aloft & crossed the Royal yd
steering S by E under all sail
finished washing &c &c

" " " Friday 18th
Commenced with a fine breeze from
the S by E steering under all sail
employed in washing ships lower masts
&c &c Middle part squally
latter part a strong breeze from S by E

For these 24 hours strong breezes steering
S by E under all sail employed in
various jobs sent down fore & main masts
safts breaking out water drying &c &c

This day at 2 P.M. came to an anchor in the harbor of Lahine
10 ships in port

Monday 21st To Tuesday 6th December
This day at 2 P.M. weighed anchor and left
the green hills of Tahina Capt came on board
strong trades. running towards Honolulu
Middle part the same latter part at
daylight off the harbor Capt & boats crew ashore
for duties &c &c

" " " Wednesday 22nd
For these 24 hours off and on, fine weather
Bark Massachusetts off and on

" " " Thursday 23rd
For these 24 hours off and on in company
with Bark Massachusetts nothing doing save
working ship &c &c &c

" " " Friday 24th
This day at 4 P.M. Capt came on board
and stood off shore wind light variable
Middle & latter parts the same in
company with Bark Massachusetts

" " " Saturday 25th
This day for the first part light variable
winds steering S under all sail took the
anchors on the bows &c &c Middle part
the same latter part a fine breeze from
the S by E steering S by E under all sail
took in the waist boat to repair

" " " Sunday 26th
For these 24 hours strong breezes from
S by E steering by the wind S by E & decline
Bark Massachusetts on the weather bow
" " " Lat per Obs. N Long

" " " Monday 27th
For these 24 hours strong trades & rugged
steering S by E employed in repairing waist
boat &c &c a sail off weather quarter

" " " Tuesday 28th
For these 24 hours the same employed
in small jobs setting up S by E S by E back steady
