Saturday 15th

This Day Begins With Strong winds from the S.W. Strong to the S.E. & doubled Ruffled the topsails & by 2 o'clock in full bending to the S.E. had fair squalls ahead I put the main mast Sheered off. I saw two in Little Bay of obs. 39.56 Long by Acc 87.60

Dec. 27 1874

This Day Begins with strong winds from
the S.W. Huring of the 13 & 14
Took in the forenoon had Rain until
past Noon. Last part clear S.E. & fair
in City but of the 13, 90 by of the 14
