Thursday June 10th

This day begins with light breezes from the N.W. steering by to the N.E. at 3 P.M. finished steering down at 7 P.M. in sail Middle & last part light winds some fog at 4 P.M. 40.10 by 4 P.M. 38.60

Friday 11th

This day begins with light winds from the N.W. steering by to the N.E. some fog Middle part light winds last part fresh wind from the S steering by to the E. at 4 P.M. 41.00 by 4 P.M. 37.11

Saturday 12th

This day begins with fresh winds from the S.E. steering by to the E. at 7 P.M. doubled kept the topmasts and main topmasts last part wind at steering S.E. one sail in late at 4 P.M. 40.50 by 4 P.M. 36.50

Sunday 13th

This day begins with fine winds from the N.W. steering S.E. Middle & last part the same two new ships at 4 P.M. 40.05 by 4 P.M. 32.30

Monday 14th

This day begins with light winds from the N.W. steering S.E. Middle part the same at 4 P.M. two the Island of St. Peter & St. Paul 30 miles last part light air & clear at 4 P.M. 37.21 by 4 P.M. 30.57 20 miles to the East of ship

Tuesday 15th

This day begins with light air & clear one sail in late except in hoisting our sail on deck at 7 P.M. the S.E. 20 miles Middle part wind S.E. & steering by to the E. last part steering winds then bearing West at 4 P.M. 37.06 by 4 P.M. 31.00

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Wednesday June 16th

This day begins with fresh winds from the S.E. steering by to the E. Middle part heading to the S.W. last part heading to the E. at 4 P.M. 37.16 by 4 P.M. 29.20

Thursday 17th

This day begins with light winds from the S.E. steering by to the E. at 7 P.M. Middle & last part fresh winds some one sail at 4 P.M. 38.37 by 4 P.M. 30.00

Friday 18th

This day begins with fresh winds from the S.E. steering by to the E. one sail in light Middle & last part light winds heading to the S.W. Sailed & passed to the windward at 4 P.M. 38.20 by 4 P.M. 29.00

Saturday 19th

This day begins with light winds from the E. heading to the N.W. the land in sight again in light Middle & last part fresh winds heading to the windward the land 25 miles off at 4 P.M. 38.55

Sunday 20th

This day begins with fresh winds from the S.E. the land 25 miles off 2 miles in light Middle & last part light winds & huffin at 4 P.M. 38.60 by 4 P.M. 28.26, the 30 miles to the E. of ship

Monday 21st

This day begins with light winds from the S.E. Sailed 20 miles off at 7 P.M. the S.E. 20 miles steering by to the N.W. Middle & last part steering off & on the land at 4 P.M. 39.15 by 4 P.M. 28.07
