This day begins with fine winds from the S steering by to the E at 17. Morning sail Middle & last part light winds from the S. E. Lat 46° 37' 41" Long 96° 38'

Thursday 12th

This day begins with light winds from the S, spoke the Albert Charnice 110th schooner Middle part calm last part light winds from the S. Steered S. E. & arrived in 2 PM. Lat 46° 38' 15" Long 96° 55' Long 96° 07'

Friday 13th

This day begins with light winds from the S steering by to the S. E. Middle part light winds last part fresh winds Steered S. E. Lat 46° 38' 26" Long 96° 00' Long 96° 28'

Saturday 14th

This day begins with fresh winds from the S steering S. E. Second set in sight at 10 AM, last part light winds Lat 46° 38' 56" Long 96° 17'

Sunday 15th

This day begins with light winds from the S steering S. E. at 4 P. M. Saw the Island of St. Louis. Steering E. Dist 60 miles & sail in sight Middle & last part light winds Lat 46° 39' 10" Long 96° 31' 00"

Monday 16th

This day begins with light winds from the S steering by to the E the land 20 miles off at 3 P. M. Saw St. Louis land & shipped on Middle part the same last part Steered for the land Lat 46° 39' 33" Long 96° 30' Long 96° 40' miles to the E ship

Tuesday August 17th

This day begins with fine winds from the S & spoke the Hawk one half down B. D. Ford at 7 AM. Saw Bone S. E. Dist 10 miles H. E. C. & last part off to on 11 at 6 AM Steered

Wednesday 18th

This day begins with light winds & fine weather off to on 11 at 6 AM Steered & last part the same

Thursday 19th

This day begins with light winds & fine weather off to on 11 at 6 AM Steered at 8 P. M. Boat came down last at 5 P. M. Steered about without clouds Middle & last part Steered to the S. E. Second set in sight Lat 46° 39' 12" Long 96° 17'

Friday 20th

This day begins with light winds from the S & W heading to the S & E with fine pleasant weather. Several ships in Co. at 4 P. M. Saw the Island of St. George bearing S. E. Dist 10 miles Middle part Steering S. E. last part Steered for the land Lat 46° 38' 03" Long 96° 42'

Saturday 21st

This day begins with light winds from the W & fine weather at 7 P. M. St. George bore S. E. at 7 P. M. Dist 15 miles saw St. George peak. Steered Middle part Steering S. E. last part Steered for St. George

Sunday 22nd

This day begins with fresh winds from the W at 3 P. M. at 8 P. M. Boat met on shore at 8 P. M. Returned heading to the S of the wind Middle part light winds last part Steering for St. George

Monday 23rd

This day begins with light winds from the S & E. Steering S. W. the cutoff in Co. at 4 P. M. St. George bearing W & W Dist 15 miles
