Monday 29th
 This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N.W. Steaming 7 P.M. Dancers have N. Dist 25 Miles Middle part Spring which lost part there 29° At 12 M. Michaels have N. Dist 15 Miles Lat 40° 34' 05" Long 40° 25' 29"

Tuesday 30th
 This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N.W. Steaming down long the land at 2 P.M. Dancers St. George at 7 the land back 12 Dist 20 Miles Middle part Spring which lost part there 29° one mile in light Lat 40° 36' 41" Long 40° 26' 06"

Wednesday 31st
 This Day Begins with light winds from the S.W. spoke the Capt. of the ship at 4 the land have N.W. Dist 20 Miles Middle part wind 24 M. lost part fresh winds today 27° Lat 40° 36' 09" Long 40° 22' 36"

Wednesday September 1st 1819
 This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N. Steaming 4 to the E.S. the Capt. in the Middle & lost part strong winds Lat 40° 36' 20" Long 40° 20' 49"

Thursday 2nd
 This Day Begins with fresh winds from the S. Steaming 4 to the E.S. at 5 P.M. spoke the ship to the S. & W. the Capt. in the Middle & lost light winds & calm Lat 40° 36' 02" Long 40° 20' 55"

Friday Sept 3rd
 This Day Begins with calm at 5 P.M. at 10 the wind N.E. with squalls of rain Middle & lost part wind N. Steaming 4 P.M. Lat 40° 36' 00" Long 40° 21' 01"

Saturday 4th
 This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N. Steaming 7 P.M. the Capt. in the Middle & lost part light winds Lat 40° 33' 22" Long 40° 20' 06"

Sunday 5th
 This Day Begins with light winds & calm the Capt. in the Middle part the same lost part light winds from the N. spoke the schooner at 10 Calm at 2 P.M. Lat 40° 32' 23" Long 40° 20' 42"

Monday 6th
 This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N. & E. Steaming 7 P.M. the Capt. in the Middle & lost part strong winds Steaming 7 P.M. Lat 40° 29' 31" Long 40° 21' 10"

Tuesday 7th
 This Day Begins with strong winds from the N. & E. Steaming 7 P.M. Middle & lost part the same Lat 40° 26' 00" Long 40° 21' 38"

Wednesday 8th
 This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N. & E. Steaming 7 P.M. with all running sail lost Middle & lost part the same Capt. in the Capt. out between decks Lat 40° 26' 11" Long 40° 22' 34"

 This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N. & E. Steaming 7 P.M. with all running sail lost Middle & lost part the same Lat 40° 21' 15" Long 40° 22' 36"
