Wednesday 12th  
This day begins with light winds from the S & steering for all day on in at 5 P.M. came to anchor 40 fathoms down

Thursday 24th  
This day begins with light winds & fine weather at 4 P.M. got under way & steered out of the harbor but just before the land 4 miles off

Friday 25th  
This day begins with light winds from the W.W. steering by along the land to the N.E. all of the night Cape S.W. & W. dist 20 miles Middle part wind S.E. last part squally with in with backing to the N.W. In P.M. set by at 55.00  
log of Ch 175.00 East

Saturday 26th  
This day begins with strong winds from the S.E. steering by to the N.W. & under short sail at 11 P.M. last part strong winds & clear weather  
set by obs 55.54 log of Ch 175.04

Sunday 27th  
This day begins with strong winds from the S.E. & steering by to the N.W. & under short sail at 11 P.M. last part more moderate  
set by obs 52.54 log of Ch 176.05

Monday 28th  
This day begins with fresh winds from the S.E. steering by to the N.W. & under short sail at 11 P.M. last part the same course and sail  
set by obs 52.05  
log of Ch 176.42

Tuesday March 29th  
This day begins with light winds from the S.E. steering by to the N.W. & under short sail at 11 P.M. last part more moderate the same last part spoke the Miller 33.0  
set by obs 51.32 log of Ch 177.45

Wednesday 30th  
This day begins with fresh winds from the S.E. the Miller in the middle part more strong to the S.E. last part strong winds & under  
set by obs 51.33 log of Ch 177.66

Thursday 31st  
This day begins with strong winds from the S & steering by to the S.W. & under short sail the Miller in the middle & last part the same  
set by obs 52.40 log of Ch 177.35

Friday April 1st 1840  
This day begins with fresh winds from the S & the Miller in the middle wind & steering to the S last part wind S.W.  
set by obs 53.00 log of Ch 178.37

Saturday 2<sup>d</sup>  
This day begins with strong winds from the S.E. steering by to the N.W. & under short sail the Miller in the middle & last part the same  
set by obs 53.00 log of Ch 179.14 East

Sunday 3<sup>d</sup>  
This day begins with fresh winds from the S.W. steering by to the N.W. & under short sail 2 sail in light Middle part wind S.W. last part backing to the S.E.  
set by obs 52.20 log of Ch 179.62

Monday 4<sup>th</sup>  
This day begins with fresh winds from the W.W. steering by to the N.W. & under short sail the Miller in the middle & last part the same last part steering to the S & under  
set by obs 52.30  
log of Ch 180.32
