Monday Aug 9th

This Day Begins with strong winds from the S.W. Saw the land 20 miles off at 6 took in sail and went steering S.W. heading to the N. Middle 3 last part rainy. Barometer 29.40 at 30.30 Log of 17 00 50

Tuesday 10th

This Day Begins with strong winds from the S.W. with thick rainy weather low the clouds at 7 shortened sail heading to the N. Middle part the same last part constant rain. Barometer 29.20 Log of 17 30 40

Wednesday 11th

This Day Begins with fresh gales from the S.W. with constant rain heading to the N. Middle part and the wind W. then to the N. last part strong S.W. one sail in light low the clouds cleared. Barometer 29.60 Log of 17 50 20

Thursday 12th

This Day Begins with strong winds from the W.S.W. strong S.W. at 8 P.M. saw Sunday Island at 6 brought to anchor 5 miles off heading W. Middle part the same last part clear at 8 P.M. at 11 P.M. the squalls & rain took blowing a gale brought to the N. Middle. Barometer 29.25 Log of 17 45 45

Friday 13th

This Day Begins with strong gales from the S.W. by day low heading to the N. Middle part the same moderate last part clear at 2 to end. Barometer 29.30 Log of 17 40 00

Saturday 14th

This Day Begins with strong winds from the S.W. steering S.W. at 6 brought to the N. Middle part the same last part led to the S. one sail in light had squalls of rain & rain to end. Barometer 29.14 Log of 17 50 00

Sunday Aug 15th

This Day Begins with fresh winds from the S.W. at 8 P.M. at 10 P.M. saw 10 miles off land struck one & killed five at 6 P.M. low along side & took in sail one sail in light Middle part the same last part clear in cutting to end at 4 P.M. 26.55 Log of 17 50 35

Monday 16th

This Day Begins with fine winds from the S.W. Emptied in cutting at 5 finished one ship in light at cutting at 15 began to sail Middle 3 last part sailing. Barometer 26.25 Log of 17 50 50

Tuesday 17th

This Day Begins with fresh winds from the S.W. Emptied in sailing with squalls of rain one sail in light Middle part the same last part finished sailing 2 miles in light. Barometer 26.14 Log of 17 50 40

Wednesday 18th

This Day Begins with fine winds from the S.W. to sail in light at 6 W.S.W. to the W. shortened sail Middle part wind S.W. last part Emptied in storing down low a squall going quick to the windward land with the sunset. Barometer 26.06 Log of 17 50 00

Thursday 19th

This Day Begins with fine winds from the S.W. Emptied in storing down at 6 finished Middle 3 last part fine weather heading to the N. Barometer 25.51 Log of 17 50 30

Friday 20th

This Day Begins with fine weather Emptied in breaking out at 6 P.M. spoke the Fairway of Sydney Middle 3 last part light air & calm two ships in light one in sailing. Barometer 26.25 Log of 17 50 00
