Saturday 18th

This day begins with fine weather. Getting ready for sailing. Middle part the same. Last part back off.

Sunday 19th

This day begins with fine weather. Back off saw a few whales. Middle part the same. Last part saw whales struck one & parted the line.

Monday 20th

This day begins with fine weather. The gunnery came in - last part back off.

Tuesday 21st

This day begins with fine weather. Middle & last part fresh wind.

Wednesday 22nd

This day begins with fresh wind from the S. saw one whale. Middle & last part the same.
