Wednesday 22nd
This Day Begins with light winds from the S steering E. & S the land in sight Middle & last part fresh winds from S.W. Lat 46° 36' N Long 4th 174° 15'

Thursday 23rd
This Day Begins with strong winds from the W. S.W. steering E. S. E. Debbled. Kept the topsails at Middle & last part fresh gales Lat 46° 56' N Long 4th 179° 39' East

Friday 24th
This Day Begins with fresh winds from the S steering E. to the E Middle part steering last part clear weather Lat 46° 36' N Long 4th 181° 09'

Saturday 25th
This Day Begins with light winds from the S. E. steering E. to the E & kept in standing sails Middle & last part calm Lat 46° 38' N Long 4th 180° 28'

Sunday 26th
This Day Begins with a calm kept in standing sails Middle & last part fresh winds from N.W. steering S. E. Lat 46° 38' N Long 4th 180° 54'

Monday 27th
This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N.W. steering S. E. Middle & last part the same Lat 46° 40' N Long 4th 182° 05'

This Day Begins with fine winds from the W. steering S. E. & S Middle & last part the same Lat 46° 42' N Long 4th 183° 04'

Wednesday 29th
This Day Begins with fine winds from the W. & W. steering S. E. & S at 6 P.M. the wind S.W. doubled. Kept the topsails Middle & last part Wind S. Lat 46° 42' N Long 4th 184° 34'

Thursday 30th
This Day Begins with light winds from the S steering to the E Middle part the wind E steering to the S at 10 A.M. the W. W. blows down. Struck 2 & killed them Lat 46° 43' N Long 4th 184° 51'

Friday ~~Monday~~ December 1st
This Day Begins with strong winds from the N. the hanks off last at 6 P.M. at 7 A.M. the W. blows to the ship & back in said blow a gale Middle part the same last part calm in cutting blowing & rainy Lat 46° 43' N Long 4th 186° 55'

Saturday 2nd
This Day Begins with a gale from the S finished cutting one 1/2 of course on the other at 7 left off cutting last part calm in cutting finished & last hanks heads Lat 46° 43' N Long 4th 188° 15'

Sunday 3rd
This Day Begins with fresh gales from the S.W. at 4 P.M. began to veer Middle & last part Wind S.W. & W. Lat 46° 43' N Long 4th 188° 33' East

Monday 4th
This Day Begins with fresh winds from the W. kept in boiling steering to the S & W Middle part the same last part blowing a gale from the N. S. W. Lat 46° 43' N Long 4th 189° 06' West
