Sunday Dec 3th

This Day Begins with a gale of wind from the N.W. with a heavy sea heading to the S. Except in Boiling Middle part the same at 7 P.M. finished Boiling last part heading to the S. & E. at 4 P.M. 43° 37' long by the 173° 52'

Wednesday 6th

This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N.W. heading to the S. & W. one sail in sight at 7 P.M. Ship to the N. & W. Middle part the same last part Except in Boiling Town between decks
Lat of obs. 43° 28' long by the 173° 50'

Thursday 7th

This Day Begins with fine winds from the N.W. Except in Boiling Town at 1 P.M. saw 2 Whales and with no success finished Boiling oil Middle part Squid & saw a large quantity of the S.W. last part Boiling a gale being under that sail heading to the S. & W. at 4 P.M. 43° 16'
Long by the 176° 03'

Friday 8th

This Day Begins with strong gales from the S.W. with a heavy sea heading to the N.W. under short sail Middle & last part had gales. Lat of obs. 42° 38'
Long by the 173° 48'

Saturday 9th

This Day Begins with hard gales from the N.W. & S.W. Sping under short sail heading to the S. & W. Middle & last part the same at 4 P.M. 41° 68'
Long by the 173° 30'

Sunday 10th

This Day Begins with a gale from the S.W. Sping under short sail heading to the S. & W. Middle part above the water last part under short sail
Lat of obs. 41° 22' long by the 173° 56'

Monday 11th

This Day Begins with light winds from the N.W. at 4 P.M. ship to the S. Middle & last part wind N.W. Steady S.W. by S.
Lat of obs. 41° 50'
Long by the 174° 30'

Tuesday Dec 12th

This Day Begins with fresh winds from the N.W. at 6 P.M. had the wind of more ship to the N.W. & Shortened sail Middle & last part light winds one sail in sight at 4 P.M. 41° 50'
Long by the 174° 56'

Wednesday 13th

This Day Begins with light winds from the N.W. saw 2 Whales going quick to the windward saw a ship to the N.W. to the second Middle part wind at last part blowing strong
Lat of obs. 42° 15' long by the 175° 17'

Thursday 14th

This Day Begins with fresh gales from the N.W. at 5 P.M. more ship to the S. & E. Middle part the same last part heading to the S. & W. at 4 P.M. 42° 60'
Long by the 174° 53'

Friday 15th

This Day Begins with fine winds from the N.W. heading to the S. & W. Middle & last part light winds at 4 P.M. 43° 06'
Long by the 174° 27'

Saturday 16th

This Day Begins with light winds from the N.W. heading to the S. & W. Shortened sail Middle & last part light winds at 4 P.M. 43° 36'
Long by the 176° 50'

Sunday 17th

This Day Begins with light air from the S. & W. heading to the S. & W. Shortened sail Middle & last part heading to the N.W. wind at 4 P.M. 43° 30'
Long by the 175° 47'

Monday 18th

This Day Begins with light winds from the S. heading to the N.W. at 8 P.M. saw the Chatham Islands being 24 miles away ship to the S. & E. wind S.E. Middle & last part wind at 4 P.M. 45° 21' long by the 176° 67'

Tuesday 19th

This Day Begins with fresh wind from the S. at 11 P.M. Shortened sail Middle & last part fine weather
Lat of obs. 43° 29'
Long by the 176° 51'
