Tuesday, January 30th 1872
This day begins with fine winds from the N & E heading to the N. W. the morning in Cal. at 7 Shortened sail last part heading to the N. E. Lat of obs. 42° 26' long by the 174° 34'

Wednesday 31st
This day begins with fine winds from the N. heading to the N. E. with heavy weather Middle part the same. last part Wind S. W. Steering to the S. E. at 10 p.m. foggy
Lat of obs. 42° 18' long by the 175° 47'

Thursday February 1st
This day begins with strong breezes from the S. W. heading to the S. E. under short sail Middle & last part light winds Lat of obs. 42° 36' long by the 172° 45'

Friday 2nd
This day begins with light winds from the S. W. heading to the S. E. Middle part Wind W. same morning at 11 A.M. had a change of wind to the N. heading to the W. Lat of obs. 42° 59' long by the 173° 25'

Saturday 3rd
This day begins with fresh winds from the S. Steering to the N. Middle part light winds at 5 A.M. saw St. Wholes passed struck one & killed her at 12 noon her along side & made fast two ketches to cut Lat of obs. 42° 54' long by the 173° 50'

Sunday 4th
This day begins with strong breezes from the N. heading with the whole along side Middle part three students at 7 A.M. began to cut last part Wind S. W. Lat of obs. 43° 00' long by the 173° 34'

Monday 5th
This day begins with light winds from the S. E. in cutting at 7 finished Middle part Euphrat in cutting up bank last part Boiling foggy Wind S. Lat of obs. 43° 00' long by the 173° 50'

Chatham Islands 1872

Tuesday Feb 6th
This day begins with strong winds from the N. Boiling at 11 A.M. looked down blowing a gale with rain heading to the N. E. Middle part the same last part Wind S. W. Boiling Lat of obs. 42° 55' long by the 173° 12'

Wednesday 7th
This day begins with a gale from the S. W. Boiling heading to the N. E. W. with a heavy sea Middle part last part the same Lat of obs. 42° 24' long by the 173° 01'

Thursday 8th
This day begins with strong winds from the S. W. heading to the S. E. Euphrat in Boiling at 7 more ship to the N. made some sail Middle part moderating last part Wind S. Euphrat in Boiling Lat of obs. 42° 16' long by the 173° 40'

Friday 9th
This day begins with light winds from the N. E. Steering S. W. Euphrat in Boiling down Middle & last part strong winds with thick weather Lat of obs. 43° 10' long by the 175° 00'

Saturday 10th
This day begins with fresh winds from the N. Steering S. W. W. thick & some rain at 1 P.M. had the Wind S. E. Middle part Boiling a gale last part Euphrat in Boiling down oil heading to the S. E. W. Lat of obs. 43° 26' long by the 176° 17'

Sunday 11th
This day begins with fine Wind from the S. E. Steering to the S. E. W. at 6 P.M. saw one of the Chatham Islands at 7 the land 15 miles off Wind light Middle & last part light rain Lat of obs. 43° 54' long by the 176° 32' 15 miles to the West of ship

Monday 12th
This day begins with fine winds from the S. W. the land 5 miles off saw two islands Middle & last part working up to the land. saw the Chatham & Pitt Islands Lat of obs. 44° 05' long by the 176° 57' 20 miles to the W. of ship
