Saw Grampuses & got a few hard Peaches and a small mep of fish Middle part Moderate breeze Steering N. by W. Latter part fresh breeze from the Southward Steering N. W. by N. S. S. in sight watches Employed drawing and knotting yarns

Steering N. W. This is the birthday of the Glorious Washington the father of our country and I suppose it will be celebrated by Balls and Parties &c

Friday Feb 23rd

Continued strong breeze from S. E. Steering N. W. Employed in repairing fore topsail Middle and Latter part moderate breeze from S. E. Steering N. W. Employed in breaking out for water and drawing and knotting yarns &c &c

Saturday Feb 24th

First part moderate breeze from S. E. Steering N. W. finished the topsail. Middle and Latter part light breeze from the Eastward Steering N. W. Employed in various jobs about the rigging

Sunday Feb 25th

Still continued light breeze from the Eastward Steering N. W. Middle and Latter part the same Steering N. W. fine pleasant weather Employed as usual on the Sabbath

Light breeze from the Eastward Steering to the N. W. the remainder of this day the same Employed in breaking out for meat. Flour Coffee Rice &c &c
