

Remarks On Board Of Bark Lydia Of N. B.

Friday June 1st 1866.

Commenced light breezes from the North heading by the Wind. Middle and Latter part strong breezes heading to the E. N. E. attended with squalls of rain and snow. So Ends

Lat Obs 56. 20 N. Long by Chron 172. 45 E.

Saturday June 2nd

Continues strong breezes from the North heading to the N. E. Middle and Latter part strong breezes trying to get to the North.

Lat Obs 56. 40 N. Long by Chron 173. 50 E

Sunday June 3rd

The wind and weather continues the same. Middle and Latter part moderate breezes from the Northward heading by the wind to N. W. No Obs

Monday June 4th

First part Moderate breezes and cloudy from the Northward heading to the N. W. the remainder of this day light breezes and pleasant weather heading by the wind on different tracks.

Lat Obs 58. 15 N. Long by Chron 174. 01 E

Tuesday June 5th

Fine weather and light breezes from the Northward heading by the wind to the Eastward. Middle and Latter part light breezes from the Eastward heading to the N. N. E. Saw a strange sail. Part of the time foggy and hazy weather.

Lat Obs 59. 16 N. Long by Chron 173. 30 E

Wednesday June 6th

Continues light breezes and hazy from the Eastward heading N. E. put up grows next. Middle and Latter much the same as the first part nothing in sight worthy of remark.

Lat Obs 60. 12. Long by Chron 173. 40 E

Thursday June 7th 1866

Still continues light Northerly winds and foggy, hazy weather tacking ship occasionally trying to get to the North. Middle and Latter part light breezes and foggy from the Eastward heading N. E. by the wind

Friday June 8th

Continues light breezes from E. S. E. heading N. E. and thick fog. Middle and Latter part light E. S. E. wind and thick fog heading to the N. E. So Ends

Lat 61. 00 N. Long by Chron 178. 22 E

Saturday June 9th

Continues light breezes and foggy 4 P.M. the fog lifted, nothing in sight, heading N. E. Middle part clear. Saw the Land near Cape Thaddeus 2 Sails and the Ice. Latter part thick fog. Saw some Ice. Lying a back for the most part of the time tacking ship occasionally.

Sunday June 10th

Light breezes and foggy first part of this day Lying a back. Middle part the same. Latter part moderate breezes from the Westward heading various ways to clear the Ice. Several Ships in sight. Spoke Barks Mt. Wallington, Willes N. B. Barks Europe Pearce N. B. Barks Eagle, McKenney N. B. Ends cloudy weather & a glorious calm. to begin the season with. So Ends

Cloudy

Monday June 11th

Continues the same 4 P.M. Spoke Ship Gov Throop. Ashley of N. B. heading by the wind part of the time the balance Lying a back. Middle part foggy Latter part lit up Saw some Ice and the Land all along shore and 9 Ships wind from the Westward light heading N. by E. So Ends
