Saturday Oct 20th 1866^{1/2}
Commence fresh breeze from S. S. E
succeeding E. by N. washing bone. 1 Ship in sight.
Middle part moderate from S. S. W. Steering S. E. by E
Latter part light Steering S. E. Employed in washing
and drying bone. Ends almost Calm
Lat Obs 35. 00 N. Long 154. 15 W

Sunday Oct 21st
Continues light air heading S. E.
Middle and Latter parts light air and Calm
just rate pleasant weather. drying bone
Lat Obs 35. 35 N. Long by Chron 153. 55 W

Monday Oct 22nd
The Weather continues the same.
Middle and Latter part light air and Calm heading
for the most of them to the Eastward. Employed in
washing and drying bone. Saw a Pinback
Lat Obs 34. 50 N

Tuesday Oct 23rd
Still continues light air almost calm
middle and Latter part light breeze from S. S. E head-
ing E. N. E. by the wind. drying bone and other
little jobs. fine pleasant weather but head wind
Lat Obs 34. 14 N Long 152. 33 W

Wednesday Oct 24th
The Weather still the same. Middle
part light breeze from the Eastward Steering from S. by E
to S. S. W. Latter part calm finished drying bone. Employed
repairing an old fore topsail, & various other jobs
Lat Obs 34. 02 N. Long by Chron 152. 34 W

Thursday Oct 25th
Continues calm & bent fore topsail
and bent another 6 Pk light breeze from the North Steering
S. S. E. Middle and Latter parts light air Steering S. E.
Employed repairing old sails and other jobs
Lat Obs 33. 36 N. Long 152. 27 W

Friday October 26th 1866^{1/2}
Continues light air from N. E Steering
S. S. E. repairing old sails. Middle and Latter part the
same as the former repairing sails & working in the rigging
Lat Obs 33. 18 N. Long by Chron 152. 25 W

Saturday Oct 27th
Light air as usual the first part of this day from
S. W. trying to steer S. S. E. Middle part light breeze Steering S. S. E.
Latter part heading S. E. by the wind. Employed in
repairing an old topsail and various other jobs about
the rigging. Saw one strange sail. Nothing more.
Lat Obs 32. 15 N. Long by Chron 151. 42 W

Sunday Oct 28th
Continues moderate breeze from S. S. W
heading S. E. by the wind. Middle part the same. Latter
part fresh breeze Steering by the wind to the S. S. E. to S. E. at
10 P.M. Spoke the Bark President. 10 Whales the season.
Lat Obs 30. 50 N. Long by Chron 149. 57 W

Monday Oct 29th
Fresh breeze from the Southward Steering
by the wind to the S. E. in company with the President.
Middle and Latter part fresh breeze from South & West
heading from S. E. to S. S. E. President in sight
Employed repairing the main sail. &c. &c.
Lat Obs 29. 20 N. Long by Chron 148. 17 W

Tuesday Oct 30th
The wind and weather continues the
same. heading S. S. E. finished main sail. Middle
part equally. Latter part fresh breeze heading about S. E.
Employed in washing ship inside. S. Ends
Lat Obs 28. 08 N. Long 147. 00 W
