

Remarks On Board Of Bark Lydia Of New Bedford

Wednesday October 31st 1866

Continued the same 3 P.M.
tacked to the Westward & Q. tacked again to S. E.
finished washing ship. Middle and Gutter part
fresh breezy & squally with showers of rain from S. & W.
heading from S. E. to S. S. E. Employed in various jobs.

Lat 26.30 N. Long 146.20 W.

Thursday November 1st

Continued fresh breezy 3 P.M. wind shifted
to N. W. Steered S. W. by S. fresh breezy the rest of this day
from the N. W. Steering S. W. by S. Employed in various jobs

Lat 24.20 N. Long by Chron 148.06 W

Friday Nov 2nd

First part fresh breezy from N. N. W.
Steering S. W. Employed in bundling bone
Middle part fresh breezy Steering S. W. Gutter part
moderate breezy from N. E. Steering S. W. bundling bone

Lat Obs 22.30 N. Long by Chron 150.16 W

Saturday Nov 3rd

Moderate breezy the first part of this
day from N. E. Steering S. W. finished bundling the
bone. Middle and Gutter part fresh breezy from E. N. E.
Steering S. W. Employed in breaking out Shooks and
Sundry other jobs. Ends much the same.

Lat Obs 20.50 N. Long by Chron 153.07 W

Sunday Nov 4th

Continued fresh breezy from Eastward
Steering S. W. 4 P.M. bent the chains. Middle and
Gutter part fresh breezy Steering from S. W. to W. N. W.
10 A.M. saw the Land and steered for it.

at Meridian light breezy
Steering as near as possible
for Byron Bay Heilo

Monday November 5th 1866.

Continued light breezy from N. E.
Steering towards Heilo 5 P.M. came to anchor and
furled the sails. Several Whale Ships in Port. Squally
with some rain the rest of this day. Washing ship
outside. So Ends this day

Tuesday Nov 6th

Through these 24 hours moderate weather
and heavy swell. little or no rain breaking out Oil to ship
home in ship Gov Throop.

Wednesday Nov 7th

All these 24 hours very little rain. Employed
breaking out Oil and putting it on board of G. S. and various
other ships

Thursday Nov 8th

First part of this day put our Bone about
7000 lbs on board of Schooner from Honolulu. Middle and
Gutter part some few showers of rain. Employed in breaking
out Oil and putting along side Gov Throop.

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Friday Nov 9th

State the same. finished with the Oil
Employed the rest of the day. Stowing empty casks and
filling them with salt water & getting off Beef & Pork from
the Shore where we left it in the Spring.

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Saturday Nov 10th

Employed in breaking out and
stowing off the After Hold. Plenty of rain. bringing
off Provisions from the Shore and stowing it aboard
and numerous other jobs. from this time I shall not
write any more while lying in Port. Unless
something of importance occurs.
