

Remarks On Board Of Bark Lydia Of New Bedford

Friday November 30th 1866

At 1 P.M. Squared the yards from off Honolulu for the Coast of California. Middle part fresh breeze from the Eastward Steering North. Latter part much the same Steering by the wind to the N. N. E. while lying at Hilo. Shipped our Oil and bone. got wood and water took on board our provisions we left there last spring. discharged Mr Wilson Second Mate and 10 Men. Shipped a fourth Mate and 10 Men. at Honolulu discharged Mr Brown Chief Officer. Shipped a Mate and Second Mate and Cooper and left. So Ends.

Continues fresh trades heading N. by E. Stowed chains and Anchors. unbent Main sprit and bent another. Middle and Latter part fresh breeze and Squally from East heading N. N. E. by the wind. Employed in fitting the boats. Saw Pinbacks

Sunday Dec 2nd

Fresh breeze the first part of this day from the Eastward heading N. N. E. by the Wind the balance of this day the same heading N. by E.

Still continues Strong trades heading to the N. by E. Saw Pinbacks. Unbent Main top sail and bent another. Middle part Strong trades Latter part fresh trades heading N. E. Employed in repairing Main top sail. finished. Saw Pinbacks

Still continues Strong breeze from S. W. Steering E. N. E. Middle part Strong breeze and Squally with rain. Latter part Strong breeze and heavy swell from S. W. Ends the same. Watches Employed Various jobs.

Friday Dec 7th

Strong breeze and Squally heavy swell from N. W. Steering E. N. E. Middle and Latter part light air and calms. heading E. N. E. Ends Cloudy. Watches Employed in Sunday jobs about the Rigging

Saturday Dec 8th

Commences light air heading Various ways. Middle and Latter part light breeze from the South Steering N. E. by E. Watches employed repairing old Sails and numerous other jobs.

Continues light breeze from S. E. Steering N. E. by E. the remainder of this day the same & Cloudy

Monday Dec 10th

First part fresh breeze from N. N. W. and rainier Steering E. N. E. Middle part the same. Latter part Strong breeze and quite rugged from West Steering E. N. E.
