

Remarks On Board Of Bark Lydia Of New Bedford

Wednesday January 30<sup>th</sup> 1867<sup>is</sup>

All this day fine weather Saw one whale. Caught 3 Turtle one fish and a lot of Eggs &c

Thursday Jan<sup>y</sup> 31<sup>st</sup>

These 24 hours much the same as the last got half a small Bullock from the shore. Saw no Whales to day.

Friday February 1<sup>st</sup>

These 24 hours fine weather Saw one whale but he was not to be caught by us.

Saturday Feb<sup>y</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup>

Good weather all this day did not go a whaling to day. but got off 2 boats load of wood

Sunday Feb<sup>y</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup>

The weather remains the same took on board two boats load of wood and caught a fine mess of fish

Monday Feb<sup>y</sup> 4<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours fine weather Boats off whaling. Saw 3 or 4 Whales could not get fast

Tuesday Feb<sup>y</sup> 5<sup>th</sup>

Part of this day foggy. Covered the boats to look for Whales. Saw none. Got off 1 boat load of wood

Wednesday Feb<sup>y</sup> 6<sup>th</sup>

First and Middle part fine weather Latter part the same 3 boats looking for Whales 1 boat getting of wood. finished the wood and stored the most of it away got half a fine Bullock from the Spaniards

Thursday February 7<sup>th</sup> 1867<sup>is</sup>

First part boats returned caught two cow fish. Middle part Saw or heard a cow & calf. Latter part boats off Saw 2 Whales. did not get fast. came on board

Friday Feb<sup>y</sup> 8<sup>th</sup>

First part one boat turteling caught 7. Middle and Latter part fine weather boats off whaling. Saw two Whales at Meridian not returned.

Saturday Feb<sup>y</sup> 9<sup>th</sup>

Commenced fine weather 5.30 boats came on board they saw two Whales. Latter part sent two boats whaling. and covered the bit and filled it and put it between decks

Sunday Feb<sup>y</sup> 10<sup>th</sup>

First part fresh trades 3 Pelt boats returned no whale. Got half a Bullock from the shore & a few clams. Latter part fine weather 6 AM. took our Anchor and started for the weather bay with a fine breeze. and sent 2 boats whaling. at Meridian calm came to Anchor again

Monday Feb<sup>y</sup> 11<sup>th</sup>

Continues calm. 3 Pelt boats returned no fish. 4.30 took our Anchor again and at 7 O. came again in the weather bay. Latter part Covered the boats at Meridian not returned.

Tuesday Feb<sup>y</sup> 12<sup>th</sup>

Fresh breezes first part 3 Pelt 2 boats returned the James Allen came to anchor. the Massachusetts yesterday. Opened Cask of Bread. Middle part Strong breeze at 4 AM. the other 2 boats left the ship to join the others up the lagoon. Ends fine weather. the Massachusetts of San Francisco got a whale weather we have got one or not remains to be proved
