Friday May 24th

Continues strong breezes and cloudy from N. by W. heading to the N. E. Put up 6 rows Mast. at 7 P.M. tacked to westward. Middle and latter part Strong breezes and cloudy from the North heading W. by N.

Saturday May 25th

The Wind and Weather continues the same, heading heading N. E. the remainder of this day same as the former. Heaving ship occasionally trying to get to the North. So Ends

Sunday May 26th

These 24 hours continues the same heading to the westward 5 P.M. tacked to N. E. Middle part the same latter part fresh breezes from W. N. W. heading North and N. by E. saw Finbacks

Monday May 27th

Continues fresh breezes from the West and a head beat sea, heading to the Northward. Middle part Strong breezes. Latter part Moderate from N. N. W. heading to the N. E. Unbent fore and main topsails and bent others. Saw Finbacks

Tuesday May 28th 1867.

Commences strong breeze from W. N. W. heading N. by E. by the wind. Middle part Moderate from N. E. Steering N. N. W. Latter part wind East Steering N. W.
Ends Cloudy. Saw Finbacks.

Wednesday May 29th

Continues Moderate from S. E. E. at 12.30 Saw one of the Fox Islands the Western one bearing N. by E 2.5 miles. Steering N. N. W. Middle part fresh breeze and thick weather with some rain from the South Steering N. & E. Latter part Moderate Steering N. & E. Saw Finbacks

Ends Cloudy

Thursday May 30th

The Wind much the same Steering N. & E. Middle and latter part Moderate breezes from S. W. and foggy Steering N. & E. Saw Finbacks

Lat by Obs 55.40 N. Long by Obs

Friday May 31st

Continues Moderate breezes from S. W. and foggy Steering N. & E. Sent aloft cutting blocks and rose the falls. Middle and latter part Moderate breezes from the South Steering N. by E. & E. Saw Finbacks. Hazy weather

Lat Obs 57.28 N

Saturday June 1st

Commences Moderate breezes from the Southward Steering N. by E. Middle part light breezes Latter part the same Steering N. by E. with all sail set

Lat Obs 59.05 N. Long by Obs 187.17 W

Sunday June 2nd

Continues light breezes and cloudy hazy weather Steering N. by E. Middle part Steering N. E. by N. Latter part Wind from the Eastward heading N. N. E. by the wind. Nothing in sight worthy of remark.
