

Remarks On Board Of Bark Lydia Of New Bedford

Thos. B. Hathaway Master. Sandwich Islands.

Thursday November 21st 1867

All ready as soon as we get the breeze. Calm through the night. 4-30 AM Light breeze off the land. Pilot on board took out anchor and left at Meridian all clear of the reef.

So Ends -

Friday Nov 22nd

All these 24 hours. Light. Moderate Fresh breeze and fine weather. Bound for Oahu in company with the Marengo

Saturday Nov 23rd

Still continuing light trades. Middle and latter part the same 9 A.M. the Capt. left the ship for Honolulu at Meridian

Sailing off and on.

Sunday Nov 24th

Continuing the same 6 P.M. the boat returned. Light trades and calm the rest of this day.

Monday Nov 25th

Continuing light trades. Middle and latter part light breeze from the westward. at 8 AM the Mate Mr. White went on shore bag and baggage. at Meridian not returned

Sailing Off and On.

Tuesday Nov 26th

Light westerly wind at 5 pm the boat came off. Mr. Russell late Mate of the Courier came on board as Mate.
