1881 Saturday Feb 12th Comes in with fair weather and moderate breeze from S.E. Steering W. by N. E. Employed working on the rigging. Saw a bird. Then turned and run for it but saw it no more.
Lat 33° 29' Long 64° 25' E

Sunday Feb 13th This day Comes in with good weather and moderate breeze from E. N. E. Steering W. by N. E. Latter part Steering W. N. E. Saw nothing.
Lat 33° 44' Long 61° 23' E

Monday Feb 14th Comes in with strong breeze from N. E. The Course W. by N. E. Latter part continues fresh throughout the twenty four hours. Saw nothing. Saw 13th fish.
Lat 33° 40' Long 57° 22' E

Tuesday Feb 15th These twenty four hours strong westerly winds and rough sea the Bark steering W. by N. E. Middle and latter part rainy and squally. The Bark under double reef. Ends with more moderate weather. Saw nothing.
Lat 34° 00' Long 55° 00' E

Wednesday Feb 16th Comes in with northerly wind and thick rainy weather. The Bark steering W. N. E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing.
No obs.

Thursday Feb 17th This day Comes in with thick rainy weather and moderate breeze from the North steering W. N. E. Broke out a cask of Bread and cask of Flour.
Lat 34° 20' Long 51° 54' E

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1881 Friday Feb 18th This day Comes in with light winds from the North and thick weather. Middle and latter part fresh breeze and clear. Saw nothing as usual. Went to the Gaff to sail to repair.
Lat 34° 32' Long 49° 12' E

Saturday Feb 19th These twenty four hours light winds from the Westward. The Bark steering to S. W. Middle and latter part quite moderate. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with calm weather.
Lat 35° 36' Long 47° 48' E

Sunday Feb 20th Comes in with good weather and light winds from the North steering. Steering by the wind to the West N. W. Ends with southerly winds. Saw nothing of importance.
Lat 34° 46' Long 47° 00' E
Latter 46° 40' E

Monday Feb 21st This day good weather and fresh westerly winds. The Bark steering by the wind on different tacks. Middle and latter part squally. Saw Killers.
Lat 34° 59' Long 46° 09' E
Latter 46° 00' E

Tuesday Feb 22nd Comes in with good weather and light westerly winds. The Bark on the port tack steering to the Northward. Saw Killers and birds. Employed working on the rigging.
Lat 33° 10' Long 43° 13' E

Wednesday Feb 23rd first part of this day calm weather. Middle and latter part light breeze from N. E. Steering N. W. by W. N. W. Ends with good weather.
Lat 32° 52' Long 44° 49' E

Thursday Feb 24th Comes in with good weather and light winds. The Bark steering N. W. by W. Saw a vessel steering to the Eastward.
Lat 32° 05' Long 42° 37' E
