Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Thursday August 27th

These 24 hours comes in with strong breezes from the N.W. Steering S.E. W. the crew variously employed broke out molasses the middle and latter parts fresh breezes and pleasant weather employed in setting up the fore topmast rigging so close this 24 hours

Lat 30° 17' North Long 25° 44' West

Remarks Friday August 28th

Comes in clear and pleasant with a fine breeze from the N.W. Steering per compass S.E. W. employed in setting up the main topmast rigging broke out Pork and Beef the middle and latter parts light and pleasant breezes from the N.W. which gradually veered to the N.E. employed in setting up the main rigging

Lat 28° 43' Long 25° 39'

Remarks Saturday August 29th

Fine breezes and pleasant weather Steering S.E. W. the crew variously employed the middle and latter parts much the same employed in painting the fore mast nothing in sight so ends this 24 hours

Lat 26° 55' Long 25° 44'

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Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Sunday August 30th

This day comes in with fine breezes from the N.E. Steering S.E. W. employed in pickling Onions the wind continuing with squalls but the sun nothing occurring worthing of note

The Copier of duty on account of a swelling in the groin and testicles Lat 25° 00' Long 25° 45'

Remarks Monday August 31st

Fine breezes from the N.E. Steering per compass S.E. W. matters of importance occurring the fore part the wind and weather continues much the same employed in the rigging the Copier still off duty Lat 23° 26' Long 25° 49'

Remarks Tuesday September 1st

Pleasant breezes from the N.E. Steering S.E. W. W. employed in making barrel hoops the wind and weather continues much the same throughout the day the latter part employed in making of ungarn

The Copier still off duty from the same cause Lat 21° 41' Long 26° 01'
