Remarks on board Ship *Majestic* Sunday September 20th

Comes in with light breezes from S.W. by S heading S by E. At 2 Pm saw sperm whales toward 4 boats but could not fasten the remainder of the day moderate breezes accompanied with squalls of rain one sail in sight to the Eastward saw a breach but could not ascertain of what kind



Remarks Monday September 21st

The fore part of these 24 hours light breezes and squally weather heading S by E. The middle and latter parts continues about the same employed on the rigging so ends this day

Lat 704 N Long 16 25 W

Remarks Tuesday September 22nd

Strong breezes and squally weather on the wind heading S by E with all sail set the middle strong breezes from S by E accompanied with squalls of rain the latter part more moderate on the wind heading to the Southward and Eastward

Lat 622 Long 14 50

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Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Wednesday September 23rd

Dark cloudy weather on the wind on the Starboard tack heading S by E employed on breaking out water the latter part employed on sending up the masting jennants and blocks the wind continues about the same one sail in sight to the W by N

Lat 822 N Long 13 19 W

Remarks Thursday September 24th

Comes in with moderate breezes but cloudy weather at 4 Pm broke out Beef and Pork on the wind with all sail set heading most of the time S by E the remainder of the day baffling winds and rainy weather one sail in sight to the N E

Lat 5 23

Remarks Friday September 25th

Baffling winds from S by W to W by N with rain on the Starboard tack saw a finback the latter part strong breezes from the Southward at 9 Pm tacked ship and headed W by N so ends
