Comes in with moderate breezes accompanied with light squalls of rain employed on setting up the fore topmast rigging the middle part strong breezes the latter part more moderate employed on breaking out water and bread Capt. Macomber's hand has burst and is much better the Steward gets no better

Comes in with light breezes and pleasant weather steering per compass S by W at 3 P.M. took in the flying jib and mizzen topgallant sail with spade sail the remainder of the day pleasant with nothing of importance occurring the Capt's hand gets better the Steward continues the same

Fine breezes from E.S.E. steering per compass S by W the and continues the same throughout the day employed on taring down nothing more transpiring of importance
