Remarks on board of Ship Majestic of New Bedford Wednesday October

Moderate breezes and pleasant weather steering per compass South by West the crew variously employed took out Breef and Deck the latter part the wind veered to the S.E. steering S by E with strong breezes and squally weather at 3 Am took in the flying jib mizen topgallant sails and put 2 reefs in the mizen topsail so at 10 Am the wind veered to the Westward took in the fore and main topgallant sails the steward gets some butter

Remarks Thursday October 15th

Came in with strong breezes from the Westward steering N by E at 3 Pm set the fore and main topgallantsails and shook the reefs out of mizen topsail at 1 Am the wind veered to the S.W. on the Starboard tack at 8 Am tacked ship heading to the Westward one sail in sight to the Eastward

Remarks Friday October 16th

Light breezes from the Southward on the Starboard tack a heavy swell coming from the S.W. at 4 Am the wind veered to the Eastward the remainder of the day light breezes and foggy weather

Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Saturday October 17th

Light breezes and foggy weather steering per compass S by E nothing of importance occurring at 9 Am the wind hauled to the S.E. steering S by E with a pleasant breeze so ends the steward is still off duty

Remarks Sunday October 18th

Pleasant breezes from the N.E. by S steering per compass S by E variously employed the latter part strong breezes from the Northward with rain nothing in sight so ends this day

Remarks Monday October 19th

Came in with light and baffling winds from the Westward accompanied with rain at 9 Am the wind hauled to the Westward which continued until 1 Am when it veered to the S.W. on the wind heading S.E. saw one finback
