Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Wednesday November 25th

Fresh breeze from the S E by S on the Starboard
Tack at 4 Pm finished repairing the topsail
at 6 Pm struck and got a Porpoise the middle
part the wind veered to the Eastward at 2 Am
Ticked Ship heading S by E the latter part
sent down the fore topgallant sail and
repaired it and sent it up again the
Steward and Cooper continued the same

Remarks Thursday November 26th

Came in with baffling winds and squalls
from the Eastward nothing occurring the
first of these 24 hours worth of note
at 7 Am unbeat the jib and bent
another in its place the remainder of the
day employed on repairing the jib
Drove several finbacks so ends

Lat 38° 04 S Long 42° 00 E

Remarks Friday November 27th

Strong breeze from the S E steering
S E under 2 reefed topsail finished
repairing the jib the middle part
the wind gradually veered to the S W and
freshened to moderate gales and rain
This day ends with strong breezes from the
S Westward

Lat 39° 04 Long 44° 16

Remarks on board Ship *Majestic* of the *Buffon* Saturday November 28th

Strong breeze from the S W steering per compass
S E by E hove out water saw one finback
the middle part the wind veered to the
Southward at 6 Am unbeat the mainsail
The rest of the day employed on repairing
it in

Lat 38° 36 Long 47° 15

Remarks Sunday November 29th

Moderate breeze from the Southward
steering S E by E finished repairing the
mainsail and rebeat it sent up another
fore topmast standing sail boom at 4
Pm hove out Beef and Pork the middle
part light baffling winds and calms the
latter part pleasant breeze from the
Southward so ends

Lat 35° 26 Long 48° 47

Remarks Monday November 30th

Came in with strong breezes from the
Southward steering S E by E saw several
finbacks the middle part light gales and
rain from the same quarter at 7 Am broke
out Bread at 9 Am took a squall and
violent squall from the S W burst a
hole in jib so ends
