Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Tuesday January 5<sup>th</sup>

Thick foggy weather with moderate breezes from the Northward on the wind on the Starboard tack beat the flying jib the middle and latter part strong breezes from the Westward at 11 Pm the wind commenced to haul steering N E nothing occurring worthy of remark

Lat 43° 38' Long 152° 11'

Remarks Wednesday January 6<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with light and pleasant breezes from the Westward steering N E at 4 Pm the wind veered to the N W the middle part sudden and heavy squalls of wind and rain the latter part broke out Bred and water steering N E 1/2 N so ends

Lat 42° 18' South Long 154° 32' East

Remarks Thursday January 7<sup>th</sup>

The fore part fresh breezes from the S W and clear steering per Compass N E 1/2 N at 4 Pm the wind veered to the Northward the middle part the wind hauled to the Westward and increased at 7 Pm a fight occurred in the forestel between Amour Chuan and Francisco Lops a native of Brava in which both were slightly wounded by a knife which said Lops drew at the time Lat 40° 50' Long 157° 28'

Remarks on board Ship Majestic Friday January 8<sup>th</sup>

Strong breezes from the Westward steering N E 1/2 N nothing occurring of importance the remainder of the day fresh breezes from the same quarter and pleasant weather steering N E by N with all sail set the Copel Steward and Tamaree gets no better

Lat 39° 04' Long 160° 27'

Remarks Saturday January 9<sup>th</sup>

Pleasant breezes from the Westward steering N E by N variously employed the latter the wind and weather continues the same employed on hauling in the spare spars and lashing them on Deck and lashing the spars that was over the stern on the bow so ends

Lat 37° 34' Long 163° 11'

Remarks Sunday January 10<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with light and pleasant breezes from the N W steering N E by N at 4 Pm broke out Beef and Pork the middle part light breezes and foggy the latter part clear weather so ends

Lat 36° 35'
