

Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Sunday January 17th

Light and pleasant breezes employed on making Ship the fore part broke out Beef on Deck the latter part strong breezes in equals nothing occurring of importance all hands ashore on liberty so ends these 24 hours

Remarks Monday January 18th

Fresh breezes the fore part and cloudy at 1 Pm William Gordon came on board very much intoxicated and in an insulting manner demanded his discharge which Capt M refused he then said Gordon then said that he would not go in the ^{stall} Capt M then told me to put the irons on him the said Gordon resisted and we were compelled to use force to put them on and to put him in the gun but he was taken out an hour afterwards having the delirium tremens the latter part employed on unhooking the rudder

Remarks Tuesday January 19th

Pleasant breezes but hazy weather employed stripping the rudder and getting cash ready for water at 3 Pm took the rudder ashore the took the raft ashore and filed it and took it in the carpenter and blacksmith employed on taking off the rudder stock so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Wednesday January 20th

Moderate breezes with rain Capt M with a boats crew in search of a stick for a rudder stock found one the latter part employed on getting it set and stowing down water so ends this day

Remarks Thursday January 21st

Light breezes and cloudy weather employed on stowing down water at 3 Pm took the raft ashore to fill again the latter part ran one watch ashore on liberty at 1 Pm got the raft off from the shore so ends

Remarks Friday January 22nd

Light breezes and rainy weather the Starboard watch ashore on liberty employed the fore part on running down the water and taking the raft ashore the latter pleasant weather one the Starboard watch ashore on liberty employed on getting the raft from shore painting Ship &c &c
