Remarks Saturday January 28th

Light breeze and cloudy employed on painting the stern the latter part employed on water from the shore at 10 Am discharged the cooper Steward and Samaree

Remarks Sunday January 29th

Moderate breeze and pleasant weather employed on getting wood and water on board at 1 Pm finished wooding and watering the latter part nothing occurring of importance

Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Monday February 1st

Came in with pleasant breeze and fair weather nothing occurring the fore part of importance the latter part one watch ashore 2 men ran away Thomas Munroe and James Kettle the latter part employed on clearing up decks heard nothing from the men

Remarks Tuesday 2nd February

Came in clear and pleasant employed on ironing ship found one Kanacker belonging to themanuel Cortes at 6 Am missed another man Alfred Harm at 4 Am got under weigh and stood out for sea at 10 Am sent the boat ashore to look for the men employed on getting the anchor on the bow so ends

Remarks Wednesday 3rd

Light and pleasant breeze from the ENE on the wind on the Starboard tack at 2 Pm the boat came off having heard nothing from the men but bringing off 5 men in their place the latter part lying off and on
