Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Saturday February 20th

Comes in with strong breezes accompanied with heavy squalls of wind and rain under short reef fore and mizen topsails and 2 reefs in the main heading S.E. & E. The latter part more moderate variously employed.

Lat 18° 45' Long 172° 33' W

Remarks Sunday February 21st

Comes in with pleasant breezes from the Eastward steering S.E. by E with main topgallant sail set. The latter part fine pleasant weather on the wind with all sail set nothing requiring of impatience.

Lat 17° 23' Long 171° 53' W

Remarks Monday February 22nd

Pleasant breezes from the Eastward on the wind heading N.E. & E with all sail set. The latter part the guard moved to the South and Eastward heading N.E. at 4 Am broke out Beef and Pork and molasses.

Lat 15° 35' Long 171° 11' W

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Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Tuesday February 23rd

Comes in with light variable winds and squalls of rain steering per compass E.S.E. sent down the mizen topgallant sail down for repairs. The middle part heavy squalls of rain with very heavy thunders and lightnings. The wind backing the latter part pleasant broke out Bread so ends this day.

Lat 15° 49' Long 171° 02' W

Remarks Wednesday February 24th

Comes in with light backing winds at times calm employed on sorting over potatoes and onions. The latter part light pleasant breezes with an occasional squall of rain backing most of the time. N.E. & E at work on the rigging.

Lat 15° 11' Long 170° 38' W

Remarks Thursday February 25th

Comes in with light breezes from the Eastward on the wind heading S.E. & E at 4 Am saw last bearing N.E. & E and N.N.W. The latter part light breezes and pleasant weather. At 5 Am took off in light bearing S.E. & E at 9 Am left Macumba went ashore the remainder of the day being off and on.

Lat 14° 23' Long 170° 24' W
