

Remarks on board of Ship *Maryanne* Friday February 26th

Pleasant breezes from the Eastward lying off and on at 2 Pm the boat came with coconuts at 4 past 2 went ashore with assist boat and at 4 Pm the boat came off with coconuts hogs &c and 2 men missing George Beckus and Dick a man that came aboard at Mangonui the middle part lying to at 7 Am Capt. Mc. went ashore for the men so ends this day

Lat 14° 17' South Long 170° 17' West

Remarks Saturday 27th

The fore part pleasant with light breezes from the Eastward at 3 Pm Capt. Mc. came aboard with the men that was missing missing the latter part on both tacks breeze strong in squalls with rain at 4 Pm put out the waist boat

Lat 15° 14' S

Remarks Sunday February 28th

Variable winds with light squalls of rain toward the Starboard boat over for painting the latter part the wind and weather continues the same nothing of importance occurring

Lat 12° 10' South

Remarks on board of Ship *Maryanne* Monday March 1st

Pleasant breezes from the Eastward and cloudy on the wind with all sail set heading N.E. the latter part light and baffling winds at 7 Am sent down the fore topgallant sail the remainder of the day employed on mending it

Lat 11° 01' South

Remarks Tuesday March 2nd

Comes in with light and baffling winds on the Starboard tack employed on mending the topgallant sail at 4 Pm strong breezes from the N.E. tack in the topgallant sails flying jib mainsail and close reef the fore topsail the latter part the wind veered to the S.W. light and pleasant steering N.E. broke out B.C. and Port also broke out and knit a new main topsail sent the old one down for repairs

Remarks Wednesday March 3rd

The fore part light and pleasant breezes from the S.W. employed on mending the old main topsail I am unwell and unable to do duty caused by bloody urine the latter part light breezes from the Westward steering North employed on heading the fore topgallant sail and repairing the old main topsail
