Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Monday March 15th

These 24 hours comes in with pleasant breezes from the Eastward steering per compass North making of importance occurring the weather continues the same throughout the day at 1 Pm broke out Sea and Breeze employed on sorting out onions

Lat 233 North Long 16958 West

Remarks Tuesday March 16th

Comes in pleasant with moderate breezes from the Eastward at 2 Pm heavy squall of rain which continues with intervals of 2 or 3 hours the latter part the wind light and variable variously employed at 2 Pm Duck and got a surprise

Remarks Wednesday March 17th

Comes in with light squalls of rain and variable winds the middle and latter parts light breezes from the ESE on the wind on the Starboard tack saw several finbacks at ends

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Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Thursday March 18th

Clear pleasant weather with light breeze from the Eastward steering per compass North I am unable to do active duty owing to strong pains in the bowels and faintness the latter part the weather squally and wind baffling

Lat 515 N Long 17016 W

Remarks Friday March 19th

Moderate breezes from the ESE on the wind heading up at 1 Pm carried away the flying jibboom in a squall the latter part fresh breezes and squally nothing at 10 Am received a heavy squall took in the topgallants jib and doubled reef the topsails at 12 M parted the foot rope to the mizzen topsail and ripped the sail from the foot to the head fished it so ends

Remarks Saturday March 20th

Comes in with strong breezes ^{from the Eastward} which veered to the SE and moderated broke out flour the latter part the wind light and baffling unbest the mizzen topsail and commenced repairing it so ends this day
