Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Sunday March 21st

Pleasant breezes from the Southward steering N employed on mending the topsail at 4 Pm the wind veered to the S W with rain the middle part light breezes and variable the latter part moderate breezes from the E S E

Remarks Monday March 22nd

Moderate breezes from the E N E on the wind heading N with all sail set the wind continues the same through the day with an occasional squall of rain the latter part employed on making a new flying jibboom so ends this day broke out molasses at 7 Pm

Lat 547 N Long 170 41 W

Remarks Tuesday March 23rd

Came in with moderate breezes from the Eastward steering N employed on mending the mizzen topsail finished the flying jib boom and at 4 Pm sent it out bent the mizzen topsail at the same time the latter part the wind from the N E sent the flying jib so ends this day

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Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Wednesday March 24th

The first of these 24 hours pleasant breezes from the N E on the wind on the Starboard tack at 4 Pm broke out Beef and Pork the middle and latter parts moderate breezes from N E to E S E variously employed so ends

Lat 1235 N Long 171 41 W

Remarks Thursday March 25th

Fresh breezes from the E N E heading N employed on the rigging at 4 Pm broke out water the remainder of the day strong breezes in squalls with rain employed on fitting brace pendants for the fore topsail yard the carpenter employed on boarding up the after part of the house

Remarks Friday March 26th

The fore part strong breezes in squalls from the E S E on the wind heading N employed on the house and rigging Mr Tucker is sick and unable to do duty the latter part strong breezes from the E S E at 8 A tore the fore topgallant sail in shewing up sent it down the remainder of the employed on mending it
