Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Friday May 7th

Came in with moderate breezes from the Southward heading S W with whole topsails at 2 Pm tacked ship heading S E the wind gradually veering to the Westward at 4 Pm kept off East at 8 Pm took in sail and later to the wind on the Starboard tack Capt Chesemb is unwell at 12 noon ship at 4 Pm wore ship and made sail at 8 Pm saw the ice the remainder of the day working the ship through the ice to the S and Eastward the Blacksmith employed on repairing the truss to the crutch yard

Lat 59°05'

Remarks Saturday May 8th

Strong breezes from the N N E in the ice working to the Eastward under single reef topsails at 6 Pm lost reef the topsails and took in the jib and wore ship heading to the N W at 3 Pm broke out Seal. Park. Selgar. and Rice. the middle part more moderate. At 6 Am made sail wore ship and kept her along the ice to the Eastward with pleasant breezes from the N N W 3 sails in sight all working to the Eastward

Lat 58°31'

Remarks Sunday May 9th

Commences with light breezes from the N W at 1 Pm lifted N E by N all clear of the ice. At 3 Pm saw 6 sails all bound to the North. At 8 Pm took in sail heading throughout the night to the N E under double reef topsails and jib the latter part the wind increased to strong breezes under the same sail

Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Monday May 10th

Strong breezes from the N N W on the Starboard tack under 3.2. reef topsails jib and courses at 8 Pm took in sail lying under short reef fore and main topsails and 2 reef in the main the middle part strong breezes from the Northward at 12 Pm wore ship to the Westward at 5 Am made sail at 8 Am wore ship under topsails employed on breaking out water so ends

Lat 58°52'

Remarks Tuesday May 11th

Came in with light breezes from the Westward heading N N E under topsails courses and jib at 10 Pm took in sail on the Starboard tack heading N E by E at midnight calm at 5 Am made sail steering N E with light airs from the S W 2 sails in sight to the Northward so ends this day

Lat 58°18' Long 174°12' E

Remarks Wednesday May 12th

Light breezes from the S W steering E S at 1 Pm compass set N E with ^{main} topgallant sail and flying jib saw 3 sails all bound to the North at 4 Pm doubled reef the topsails steering N N E at 6 Am made sail light breezes from the Southward several sails in sight to the Eastward the latter part in the ice
