

Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Thursday June 10th

Moderate breeze from the S.W. and foggy lying too with all sail set. At 4 Am the fog cleared up kept off N.W. variously employed no ice in sight. At 3 Am kept East along the land one sail in sight to the Eastward sailing all the latter part light and variable winds from the Southward. Mr Mitchell continues the same.
Lat 62°10'

Remarks Friday June 11th

Light airs and calms heading East at 4 Am surrounded in 24 fathoms a strong current setting S.E. at 6 Am a boat came off from the shore and left at 8 Am let go the kedge with 50th chain furlled the topgallant-sails and clewed down the topsails. At 11 Am a light breeze sprang up from the N.E. at 3 Am hove in the chain the kedge being broken off close to the stock the latter part squally and thick employed on stowing board in the fore peak, working around the land. Mr Mitchell continues the same so ends this day.

Remarks Saturday June 12th

Comes in with strong breezes in squalls from the N.E. working around the land nothing in sight, finished stowing board. At 3 Pm broke out Reef and Deck. the middle part on the Larboard tack with strong breezes and rainy weather under close reef fore and mizzen topsails and double reef main at 4 Am tacked Ship heading N.W. at 6 Am set whole topsails and courses at 12 past 10 Am tacked Ship heading along the land to the Eastward. Mr Mitchell is about the same.

Remarks on board of Ship *Majestic* Sunday June 13th

This day comes in with moderate breezes from the N.W. on the Larboard tack with all sail set the weather haze a strong current setting along the land N.E. by E and S.W. by W. the middle part strong breezes under double reef topsails on the wind working along the land the latter part more moderate one sail in sight to the Eastward.
Mr Mitchell is some better.

Remarks Monday June 14th

The wind increased from the Northward to light-gales close reef the fore and mizzen topsails and double reef the main furlled the jib and mainsail the Ship *Morengo* of New Bedford in company working along the land between bays Navarin and Thaddeus the middle and latter parts more moderate. At 2 Am made all sail employed on breaking out molasses the *Morengo* in light under the land, scattering ice to the Northward so ends this day.

Lat 62°25' Long 17°42'

Remarks Tuesday June 15th

Comes in with moderate breezes and clear all sail set working along the land the wind from the N.W. by W. 2 sails in sight the wind and weather continues the same throughout the day the latter part under whole topsails employed on breaking out water so ends this day.
