Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Wednesday June 16th

The fore part fine breezes from the N.W. and clear all sail set beating along the S.W. shore of the Canadian Sea. one sail in sight variously employed. heavy ice along the land at 8 Am the wind veered to the S.E. steering per compass N.W. nothing in sight so ends this day

Remarks Thursday June 17th

Fine breezes from the E.S.E. steering along the ice the weather here 3 sails in sight on bound for the North the latter part working to the Eastward under all sail several sails in sight. the weather equally. so ends this day

Remarks Friday June 18th

Moderate breezes from the N.N.E. on the wind on both tacks with all sail set at 4 Pm bore out Lee and Dirk at 5 Pm gained with Wm and Henry of Fairhaven the latter part light breezes from the N.W. ice in sight to the Eastward nothing of importance occurring

Remarks on board of Ship Majestic Saturday June 19th

Light and pleasant breezes from the N.N.W. on the wind on both tacks all sail set 12 sails in sight at 2 Am the wind veered to the Southward and continued light throughout the day. working around the ice all sail set so ends

Remarks Sunday June 20th

This day commences with fine breezes from the S.W. all sail set working around the ice at 4 Pm came in thick fog hauled the topgallant sails and hauled up the courses the remainder of the day under topsails with fresh breezes and foggy weather so ends

Remarks Monday June 21st

Came in with strong breezes from the Southward on the wind on both tacks. saw several sails at 4 Pm. doubled reef the fore and main and single reef the mizzen. the latter part set the fore and mainsail nothing occurring worthy of note several sails in sight
