

Remarks on board Ship Majestic Saturday September 18th 1853

Commenced with fresh gale from the sw steering se under close reef fore and main topsail and fore sail at 2 Pm more moderate set mainsail and jib and 2 reef topsail at 6 Pm under topsails at 7 Pm under all sail middle squally with rain later part calm and rain backing out water and blacksmithing taking lead

Lat none Long

Remarks Sunday September 19th
Commenced with calms and rain at 3 Pm light wind from the ne steering se with all sail hild one hog at 4 Pm wind from the N later part the same saw ends

Lat 37° 12' Long 101° 15'

Remarks Monday September 20th
Commenced with moderate breeze from the N steering se with all sail at 1 Pm cleared up pleasant ship taking 3 hours pumping out of 24 at 4 Pm wind to the ne fitting new main loyft back stays and making masting for beam ends working on the rigging pleasant

Lat 36° 18' Long

Remarks Tuesday September 21st
Commenced with light wind from the ne steering se half employed on the rigging and blacksmithing middle and later part rain squally and wind backing saw ends

Lat 35° 30' Long 100° 05'

Remarks Wednesday September 22nd
Commenced with light wind and squally from all points of the compass at 2 Pm very heavy squall from the sw close reef topsails and furld top gallin sails and jibs split main top gallin sail at 4 Pm under topsails at 7 Pm under all sail at 10 Pm wind from the sw later part squally Lat 35° 54' Long 103° 58'

Remarks on board Ship Majestic Thursday September 23rd 1853

Commenced with strong wind from the sw steering se with squalls blacksmithing and mending main top gallin sail and bent it at 2 Pm took in fore and misson top gallin sail and flying jib at 10 Pm 2 reef the topsails at 2 Pm close reef fore topsail and furld the misson and hand the mainsail and jib with the wind from the S at 5 Pm under 2 reef topsails jib and main sail heading elys employed washing beam ends squally

Lat 34° 51' Long 100° 00'

Remarks Friday October 1st 1853
Commenced with strong wind from the shading elys under 2 reef topsails employed washing beam ends very squally at 2 Pm under topsails at 10 Pm 2 reef the topsails and hand the mainsail and jib ends very squally and backing

Lat Long

Remarks Saturday October 2nd
Commenced with strong wind from the so the hard heading to the e under 2 reef topsails at 2 Pm set the mainsail and jib at 7 Pm wind veered to the sw steering se and squally at 8 Pm wind to the shading se dying beam ends moderate saw ends

Lat 33° 07' Long 103° 30'

Remarks Sunday October 3rd
Commenced with strong wind from the shading se under 2 reef topsail drying beam at 2 Pm under topsails middle part the same later part very squally with plenty of rain at 11 Pm wind to the sw steering se with all sail saw ends

Lat 32° 45' Long 100° 42'
