

Remarks on board Ship Majestic Monday October 4th 1853

Commenced with strong wind from the west with all sail with rain squalls at 4 PM more moderate steering we ran fore top gallant and mizzen and clearing middle and later part light wind and baffling from all points of the compass with rain
Lat 31° 59' Long 156° 00'

Remarks Tuesday October 5th
Comes in with light wind and baffling from all points of the compass broke out squalls and mizzen falling a new main top sail runner mizzen etc and latter part calm employed on the rigging
Lat 31° 59' Long 156° 00'

Remarks Wednesday October 6th
Comes in with calm employed on the rigging middle and later with rain with light wind from the northward steering by the wind with all sail
Lat 31° 36' Long 156° 10'

Remarks Thursday October 7th
Comes in with light wind and baffling from the northward steering by the wind with all sail breaking out for water at 3 PM wind used to the east drying down and breaking out new sails and latter saw ends pleasant
Lat 30° 32' Long 156° 21'

Remarks Friday October 8th
Comes in with light wind from the E steering by the wind with all sail breaking new mainsail and foresail saw one piece saw one sail to the north of us middle part pleasant later part employed in bunking in boat ship leaking very bad
Very pleasant
Lat 28° 15' Long 156° 3'

Remarks on board Ship Majestic Saturday October 9th 1853

Comes in with light wind from the west steering by the wind with all sail employed in bunking bent and stowing it away middle part pleasant later part working ship ends pleasant
Lat 26° 44' Long 156° 33'

Remarks Sunday October 10th
Commenced with moderate wind from the west steering by the wind with all sail middle part squally and baffling at 6 PM wind used to the shading used broke out flour
Lat 24° 28' Long 157° 08'

Remarks Monday October 11th
Comes in with light wind from the shading west with all sail at 6 PM wind used to the shading used ship leaking bad middle and latter part pleasant employed on the rigging broke out meat saw ends
Lat 23° 15' Long

Remarks Tuesday October 12th
Comes in with light wind and baffling from the eastward heading from the SE to SW broke out water middle and latter part squally wind from all points of the compass saw the land Maakooone of the sandwich islands
Lat 22° 00' Long 157° 01'

Remarks Wednesday October 13th
Comes in with light wind and squally with rain saw the land at 5 PM used to the eastward and 1 mile distant land bearings middle part pleasant at 9 PM tacked ship heading ship standing into the land at 10 PM saw 2 sails to westward wind used with light squall saw mahu and mollyki saw ends
