

Remarks on board Ship *El Bajestic* Monday <sup>1883</sup> November 14<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with smoking ship men ashore later paid painting ship

Remarks Tuesday November 15<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with sending out the flying jib boom and putting out the labboard boat later part raining and blowing strong

Remarks Wednesday November 16<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with moderate wind from the S 4 men came on board and one of them fell and hurt him very bad sent him ashore for the hospital later part doing nothing seawind

Remarks Thursday November 17<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with getting under way took the anchor and went outside of the reef 10 men came on board 2 of them was run away Captain on shore light wind from the ESE laying off and on later part wind from the one fresh at 7 PM Captain came on board employed in lashing the anchors seawind one man jumped over board

Remarks Friday November 18<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong wind from the one heading on both tacks under topsails employed in fitting the boats and stowing down chain later part strong wind at 11 PM 2 reef the fore and main topsail got out head

Remarks Saturday November 19<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong wind from the one heading on saw the land 15 miles distant having off at 6 PM under topsails and main top gallin sail middle part rain squalls at 4 PM furld main top gallin sail at 10 PM wind laid to the one heading on broke out provisions one man sick below seawind  
Lat 23° 37' Long 156° 32'

Remarks on board Ship *El Bajestic* Sunday <sup>1883</sup> November 20<sup>th</sup>

Came in with strong wind and squally from the ESE at 6 PM set main top gallin sail and flying jib at 8 PM furld them again and the same saw 2 sails on with main top gallin mast gone

Lat 24° 14' Long 154° 55'

Remarks Monday November 21<sup>st</sup>  
Came in with very squally and strong wind from the ESE heading on at 1 PM set main top gallin sail and flying jib at 5 PM furld flying jib one man sick below middle part squally later part at work on the rigging Capt sick below  
Lat 25° 15' Long none

Remarks Tuesday November 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Came in squally and strong wind from the E heading on at work on the rigging at 10 PM furld main top gallin sail saw fire back at 10 PM 2 reef the fore and main topsail later part at work on the rigging saw one break once Captain sick below and 2 other foreward

Lat 26° 15' Long 154° 57'

Remarks ~~Wednesday~~ <sup>Wednesday</sup> November 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Came in with strong wind from the E then to the one backing out water at 5 PM used ship heading E at 7 PM 2 reef main top sail later part broke out plane seawind

Remarks Thursday November 24<sup>th</sup>  
Came in with strong wind from the one with 2 reef topsails employed in knotting yards middle part very squally later part the same heading on wind from the E Captain sick  
Lat 27° 26'
