

Remarks on board ship Abajestic Monday December 21st 1858

Came in with light wind from the new laying at anchor in Magdalena Bay at 8 pm boats came on board 6 sails at anchor at 8 pm Captain went on board the Irene later part took the anchor and went in shore farther employed in wooding ship with 5 boats down ends

Remarks Tuesday December 22nd
Came in with moderate weather employed in wooding ship with 5 boats the dromed has gone up the bay 4 ships and 1 schooner at anchor broke out provision saw ends

Remarks Wednesday December 23rd
Came in with moderate wind from the new laying at anchor employed in wooding ship with 5 boats later part cutting wood and packing on the beach saw ends

Remarks Thursday December 30th
Came in with strong wind from the new laying at anchor with 3 ships and 1 schooner employed in cutting wood and packing on the beach broke out for water ends with taring down

Remarks Friday December 31st
Came in with strong wind from the new employed in cutting wood and packing on the beach and taring down the Scotland wayed anchor and went to the mouth of the passage sold 5 bbls and brought on bags of unions later part the ramble and the L. B. Richmond wayed anchor and went down the bay the Captain of the dromed and the Capt of the schooner came on board employed in cutting wood saw 1 sail beating up the harbor

Remarks on board ship Abajestic Saturday January 1st 1859

Came in with strong wind from the new laying at anchor employed on the rigging later part the same saw ends

Remarks Sunday January 2nd
Came in with moderate wind from the new employed taring down one ship came to anchor the adderson later part one boat went on board the dromed 2 went taring

Remarks Monday January 3rd
Came in with moderate wind from the new laying at anchor later part 2 boats went down the bay whaling saw ends

Remarks Tuesday January 4th
Came in with light wind from the new at 2 pm wayed anchor and went out into the channel at 4 pm let go anchor in 13 fathoms of water with 40 fathoms of chain at 6 pm boats came on board without success later part light wind from the new wayed anchor at 6 pm and stardise with all sail saw humpbacks and board for them without success separating boats saw ends

Remarks Wednesday January 5th
Came in with light wind from the new steering on with all sail saw 5 sail at anchor at 6 pm dropped anchor in 13 fathoms of water with 40 fathoms of chain at 6 pm wayed anchor and went down the bay at 11 pm let go anchor and delivered up the top sails one boat of coming saw ends broke out flour bread and water

Remarks Thursday January 6th
Came in with light wind from the new at anchor saw 1 sail and board 3 boats at 2 pm at 5 pm wayed anchor and went down the bay at 9 pm let go anchor 15 fathoms of chain later part got under way again
