

Remarks on board ship Majestic Friday January 7th 1857

Came in with light wind from the new running down the bay at 2 Pm. board 3 boats for ripsacks got none came on board at 4 at 5 Pm. let go anchor in 10 fathoms of water with 15 fathoms of main saw one ship at anchor foiling at 6 Pm. board 3 boats for whale sewinds

Remarks Saturday January 8th
Came in with light wind from the new laying at anchor one schooner came in at 4 Pm. boats came on board at 6 Pm. board 3 boats for ripsacks brought 11 hundred pounds of potatoes from the schooner Ella Fraser paid him in old casks and half of butluck

Remarks Sunday January 9th
Came in calm 2 boat off whaling at 2 Pm. lab board boat struck and lost her came aboard at half past 4 Pm. at 6 Pm. board 2 boats for ripsacks at 7 Pm. 4 boats down at 11 Pm. starboard boat struck and lost her boats came on board at half past 4

Remarks Monday January 10th
Came in with calm boats down came on board at half past 4 at 6 Pm. board 4 boats for whale at 8 Pm. lab board boat struck and kild and saved one ripsack

Remarks Tuesday January 11th
Came in with moderate weather at 5 Pm. commenced towing whale to the ship at 5 Pm. took him along side and commenced to cut in

Remarks Wednesday January 12th
Came in calm employed in cutting finished at half past 8 Pm. saw the S. B. Richmond take one whale along side later part employed in biling at 9 Pm. boats went down the bay Kate is sick

Remarks on board ship Majestic Thursday January 13th 1857

Came in with strong wind from the new laying at anchor boiling at 2 Pm. boats came on board without success later part boiling at 7 Pm. 2 boats went eggig at half past 11 Pm. could down

Remarks Friday January 14th
Came in with strong wind from the new laying at anchor clearing up decks at 5 Pm. boats came on board took out molasses later part 2 boats went ganning employed in wrapping oil

Remarks Saturday January 15th
Came in with strong wind from the new laying at anchor took out water boats came on board at 6 Pm. later part making spun yarn sewinds

Remarks Sunday January 16th
Came in with moderate wind from the new laying at anchor Captain went on board the S. B. Richmond later part moderate sewinds

Remarks Monday January 17th
Came in with calm laying at anchor one boat went on board of the bark Pauline and the S. B. Richmond at 6 Pm. board 3 boats for whale saw the bark Pauline take one along side

Remarks Tuesday January 18th
Came in with light wind from the new laying at anchor at 4 Pm. boats came on board without success later part board 2 boats at 5 Pm. for whale

Remarks Wednesday January 19th
Came in with calm 3 boats chasing whale took out water saw the S. B. Richmond take one whale at 5 boat came on board without success later part board 3 boats at 8 Pm. at 9 Pm. lab board boat struck and got stove had lost the whale at 9 Pm. boats came on board with the stove boat
