steering w by s with all sail put the
anchor on the beam at 5 PM later part
broke out water sugar butter saw sail

the e steering w by s with all sail at 1 PM
steering w saw four sails later part very
squally and strong wind from the e steer-
ing w by s with all sail at 11 PM saw
the land make sounds

Remarks Monday March 21st

Come in with strong wind from the e steering
w by s with all sail at 2 PM saw no sail
Rani and Malbyki at 5 PM saw 6 PM saw at 6 PM swept the

main top sail swept fore top sail
pulled the mizen and mizen sail at 10 PM
left to the wind heading none at 5 PM
made all sail heading w saw the land
noahoo at half past 11 back the steam-
mer sounds

Remarks Tuesday March 22nd

Come in with strong wind from the e
intown by the steamer at 11 PM
let go anchor in the harbor of the harbor
later part doing nothing

Remarks Wednesday March 23rd

Come in with strong wind from the e
laying at anchor doing nothing later part
the same sounds

Remarks Thursday March 24th

Doing nothing of in port later part
hauled ship alongside of the steamer
and commenced to discharge sounds
