

Remarks on Board Ship *Majestic* Saturday April 23rd 1857

Come in with light wind from the westward
ring up half with all sail employed
in setting up shacks later part the
same

Lat 32° 54' Long 85° 00'
Remarks Sunday April 24th
Wind & weather setting up shacks
saw one sail the mate sick
later part light wind from the
steering with all sail
Lat 33° 50' Long 85° 00'

Remarks Monday April 25th
Light wind from the S steering
with all sail mate sick below
later part the same employed in setting up
shacks
Lat 34° 09' Long 85° 00'

Remarks Tuesday April 26th
Light wind and calm mate sick below
and foggy later part strong wind from the S
steering with all sail in place in setting up shacks
Lat 35° 25' Long 85° 46'

Remarks Wednesday April 27th
This day come in with light wind from the S with all sail
set the mate sick and below and the same
are setting up shacks in the steering with all sail
Lat 36° 25' Long 85° 30'

Remarks Thursday April 28th
This day come in with light wind from the S steering
with all sail set we have been at anchorage
and out but the fore shacks the mate sick and below
steering with strong wind from the westward with
all sail set
Lat 39° 19' Long 85° 00'

Remarks on Board Ship *Majestic* Friday April 29th 1857

This day come in with foggy and strong wind from the westward
with all sail set steering S. half W. employed in making
hance works at 6 P.M. we took in the mainmast and the mizzen
top galant sail and Breeze the mizzen top sail the mate
sick and below middle part the same later
part light wind and baffling from all
point of the compass saw five sails saw one sail
broke out provisions and flour

Lat 41° 14' Long none
Remarks Saturday April 30th
Come in with moderate wind from the W
and then strengthens at 10 P.M. furl the
top gallin sail and flying jib at 2 P.M.
I reef the topsails and the same

Lat 42° 27' Long none
Remarks Sunday May 1st 1857
Strong wind from the W under reef
topsail heading aboye mate sick at
11 P.M. shore out the reefs at 1 P.M.
made all sail wind veered to the S
steering new byn broke out water

Lat 43° 37' Long none
Remarks Monday May 2nd
Come in with strong wind from the S
steering new byn with all sail set
foggy mate is better later part wind
from all point of the compass and light
Lat 44° 25' Long 85° 27'

Remarks Tuesday May 3rd
Come in with calm employed in put-
ting up stores in the fore-castle and
in the cabin later part light
wind from the S steering new with all sail
Lat none Long none

Remarks Wednesday May 4th
Come in with light wind from the S steering
over at 2 P.M. strong wind and rain
at 2 P.M. reef the topsails and furl
top gallin sail we left two at 3 P.M. with a gail of
wind and the same
Lat 47° 10' Long 85° 31'
